SPIRITUAL THOUGHT

As we begin the season of Lent.

"We are ambassadors for Christ; it is as though God were appealing through us, and the appeal that we make in Christ's name is: be reconciled to God. For our sake God made the sinless on into sin, so that in him we might become the goodness of God. As his fellow workers, we beg you once again not to neglect the grace of God that you have received. (2 Cor. 5:20 ff).

From Meditations of St John Paul 11:

In this Lenten season, Jesus calls us to follow him on the way that leads him to Jerusalem to be sacrificed on the cross. "If any man would come after me, let him deny himself and take up his cross daily and follow me." Of course, this is a demanding and difficult invitation, but it can unleash the creative power of love in those who accept it. From the first moment of this season of Lent, therefore, our gaze is turned to Christ's glorious Cross.

The author of the Imitation of Christ writes: "In the Cross is salvation; in the Cross is life; in the Cross is protection from the enemy; in the Cross is the supernatural gift of the sweetness of heaven; in the Cross is strength of mind and joy of spirit; in the Cross virtue is added to virtue and holiness is perfected."


